The winning submission will be able to show a compassionate and empathetic approach to client care as well as achieving the highest standards of technical excellence.

Criteria

The winner of this award will:

- demonstrate the ability to deliver high standards of service and support to clients.
- evidence a framework of policies and procedures to which the team adhere in relation to CoP work.
- describe their firm's approach to mental capacity tests and any associated policies and procedures.
- demonstrate excellent client communication providing evidence of how your team makes it easy for people to understand the process, your role, any fees etc.
- show dedicated members of the team must spend a minimum of 50% of their time on Court of Protection work.
- provide two brief examples of where your work has helped clients to achieve resolution to their legal issues.
